All Suffolk school-children of up to and including 11 years old (Reception to Year 6) are invited to participate in Young Art East Anglia (YAEA), a competition and exhibition of children's art raising funds for Cancer Research UK. This is a wonderful opportunity for the young artists who are chosen to see their work displayed in a professional gallery. GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS AND FAMILIES

- HOW TO ENTER: Every child entering gives YAEA one piece of artwork (and assigns to YAEA their copyright in it) along with a minimum entry donation of **£2.50 per child** as their contribution to helping raise money for Cancer Research UK. (**BACS**, Cheque or cash)
- THEME: **"A Moment in Time"**. (Ideas can run free, but prizes will only be awarded to those who are "on-theme"). Work must be artist's own.
- LABELLING: Please put a sticker ([see the website for a template](#)) with child's **name, year and school** on the back of each entry with **an arrow** to indicate the top of the picture. If parents fill in their e-mail address, this will only be used to contact them in relation to Young Art East Anglia and will not be passed on or used for any other purpose.
- DEADLINE: Entries must be ready for collection by **Monday 27th, January 2020**.
- SIZE: Any size **up to A3** (42cm x 30cm). Larger work may be exhibited but will not win a prize as wall space is limited. **Unmounted and un laminated please.**
- MEDIUM: all mediums accepted but it must be original work, no photocopies will be exhibited. Overlaid and built up work but collages cannot be prize-winners (framing too difficult) and **no bulky collages or photographs please.**
- PRIZES: There are prizes for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd winners in 3 age categories: Reception, Yrs 1 & 2; Years 3 & 4; Years 5 & 6 and all prize-winning art will be framed. Our judge is Mimi Nicholson, her decision is final
- EXHIBITION: **From the work submitted, about 350 pictures will be exhibited and the artists will be notified if their picture has been chosen.**
- Each exhibited artist will receive a **certificate** to mark the occasion.
- **Postcards** of all exhibited work will be for sale at the exhibition and **the paintings** are also available for purchase, with priority being given to the artist's family.
